Respect

Abusive language, intimidation or unsporting behaviour will not be tolerated. All members must follow the rules, policies and regulations set by the Sunshine Coast Churches Soccer Association (SCCSA). Kindness, patience and good behaviours are expected from everyone in our club community.
